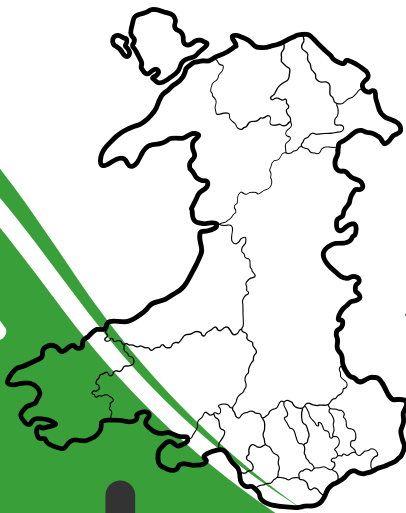

Cardiff Airport has direct flights across Europe and global links. Wales is also easily served by Bristol, Birmingham, Manchester and Liverpool airports.



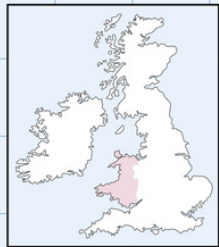
## FERRY
